



## Breast Cancer Survivors Information Sheet

**Survivor Parking** - On a first come-first served basis, parking will be available to Survivors in the Metropolitan National Bank parking garage. Entry into the site for Survivor Parking is at 6th and Spring. Survivors must be wearing their pink Survivor shirt or a pink Survivor Race bib.

**Survivor Breakfast** - 6:30 a.m., Race Day, Metropolitan National Bank Plaza at Capitol and Broadway; sponsored by Metropolitan National Bank, Kroger, Fox 16 and CW Arkansas.

**Survivor Photo** - 7:15 a.m. (SHARP), Race Day, Metropolitan National Bank Plaza; provided by Bedford Camera & Video. Photos will be distributed at the Survivor Luncheon and also available online at bedfords.com.

**Survivor Parade** - 9:30 a.m., Survivors will gather at 2nd Street and Broadway (Rose Garden Area) and proceed south to the Arkansas Democrat Gazette Race Stage (2 blocks). The Survivor Parade is an opportunity for all survivors to walk together in a show of solidarity in the fight against breast cancer! The parade will form at the Rose Garden Area (adjacent to the Pulaski County Courthouse on Broadway between Markham and 2nd Streets). Survivors are encouraged to arrive early in order to receive “party favors,” of which are limited. A brief ceremony at the Race Stage, following the parade, will honor our survivors. Race teams, Three Miles of Men, families, friends and race participants are encouraged to remain after the Race to cheer on the survivors in the parade.

**Survivor Celebration and Awards Ceremony** - 9:45 a.m. Arkansas Democrat Gazette Race Stage, on Broadway between 3rd and 4th Streets. This will include a tribute to survivors. New location for stage: it will be across the street from where it was last year (still on Broadway).

**Survivors Luncheon** - Immediately following the Survivor Parade and Ceremony, the luncheon will be held at the Robinson Center Auditorium. This informal luncheon is free to survivors who are registered for the Race and \$15 for all other guests. Payment for guests will be taken at the luncheon. Please come as you are. **Tribute to Breast Cancer Survivors** - Breast cancer survivors who wish to be recognized will be given a complimentary pink t-shirt and cap with registration. Registered Survivors also receive a pink Race bib. Donna Terrell will be our emcee at the Survivor Luncheon. Special guest Kelly Corrigan is a breast cancer survivor and author of the New York Times bestseller “The Middle Place.” She is a newspaper columnist and a magazine contributor.
